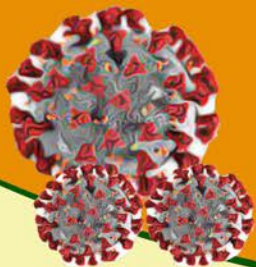

DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP TIMES

Kindly note vehicles will NOT BE allowed entry through the main gates before 6.50 am. We request parents to drop off and collect children from their designated drop-off points.

Arrival times:

Reception, Standards 1 to 7 should arrive between 6.50 am to 7.20 am.
Lessons for all standards start at 7.30 am.
