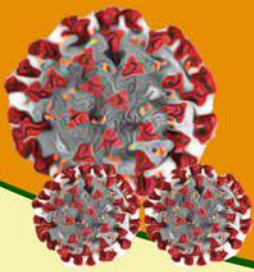

COVID 19 REGULATIONS

OUR DAILY COVID 19 OPERATIONAL PROTOCOLS

ENTRANCE PROTOCOLS

Facemasks are compulsory for all persons entering the school campus. Admission will be denied to any person who does not have a face mask on. All children have to undergo a mandatory temperature check and hand sanitization. Once the screening process at the gate is completed and requirements met, children will then proceed to their classrooms. All visitors to the school have to sanitize their hands before entering.

Kindly note vehicles will NOT BE allowed entry through the main gates before 6.50 am. We request parents to drop-off and to collect children from their designated drop-off points.

DROP OFF AND PICK UP TIMES

Arrival times:

Reception, Standards 1 to 7 should arrive between 6.50 am to 7.20 am.
Lessons for all standards start at 7.30 am.

Collection times:

Reception & Standard 1 - 12.30 pm to 12.45 pm.

Standard 2 - 2.45 pm to 1.00 pm (children who stay for remedial lessons on Tuesdays will leave at 2.15 pm).

Standards 3 & 4 - Monday - 3.15 pm to 4.00 pm.
Tuesday - 2.15 pm to 2.30 pm.
Wednesday to Friday - 1.00 pm to 1.15 pm.

Standards 5 to 7 - Mondays and Wednesdays - 3.30 pm to 4.00 pm.
Tuesday - 2.30 pm to 2.45 pm.
Thursdays and Fridays - 1.30 pm to 1.45 pm.



Kindly note, parents having more than one child in school may collect all children at the same time. Please inform the class teachers accordingly.
