Parental supervision and assistance will go a long way in ensuring children have a sound foundation and perform well at school.

Transfer letters: Kindly note a term's notice or fee in lieu of it is required when requesting for a transfer letter for your child/children. Parents who wish to transfer their children in January 2022 should inform the school without further delay.

Entrance tests for new admissions 2022: Kindly note that registration for new admissions is now open and entrance tests have already commenced. Parents seeking admission for their child/children for next year must register early to avoid disappointment as seats are limited.

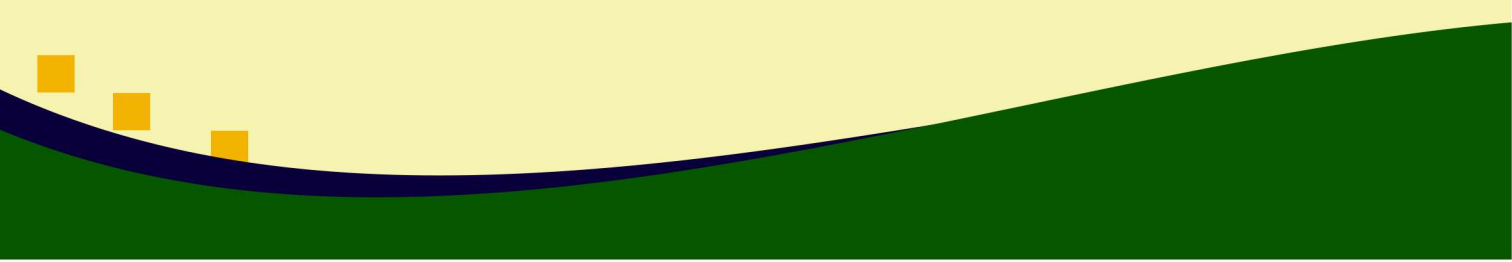

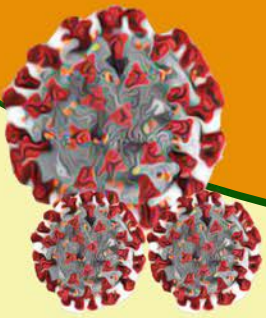

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

We would like to remind all our parents and children to continue adhering to all Covid-19 protocols.

ENTRANCE PROTOCOLS

Facemasks are compulsory for all persons entering the school campus. Admission will be denied to any person who does not have a face mask on. All children and visitors to the school have to undergo a mandatory temperature check, hand sanitisation and are required to walk through a wet foot bath. Once the screening process at the gate is completed and requirements met, children will then proceed to their classrooms. Temperatures will be recorded twice a day.



DROP OFF AND PICK UP TIMES

Kindly note children will **NOT BE** allowed entry through the main gates before 6.50am. We request parents to drop-off and to collect children from their designated drop off points.

Thursdays and Fridays 1.30pm to 1.45pm.
