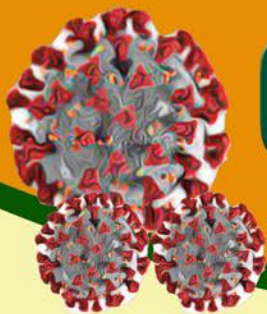

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS



ENTRANCE PROTOCOLS



Facemasks are compulsory for all persons entering the school campus. Admission will be denied to any person who does not have a face mask on. All children entering the school have to undergo a mandatory temperature check, hand sanitisation and are required to walk through a wet foot bath. Once the screening process at the gate is completed and requirements met, children will then proceed to their classrooms.

Only children and staff are allowed beyond the red tapes and through the small gates.

DROP OFF AND PICK UP TIMES

Kindly note children will **NOT BE** allowed entry through the main gates before 6.50am. We request parents to drop-off and to collect children from their designated drop off points.

Arrival times :

Reception, Standards 1 to 7 should arrive between 6.50 am to 7.20 am.

Lessons for all standards start at 7.30am.

Collection times:

Reception & Standard 1- 12.30pm to 12.45pm.

Standard 2- 12.45pm to 1.00pm.

Standard 3- 1.00pm to 1.15pm.

Standard 4- 1.15pm to 1.30pm.

Standards 5 to 7

Mondays to Wednesdays 2.15pm to 2.30pm.

Thursdays and Fridays 1.30pm to 1.45pm.

Kindly note parents having more than one child in the school may collect all children at the same time. Please kindly inform the class teachers accordingly.

We request parents to keep children at home if they have any flu-like symptoms. If a parent, child, sibling or any other household member tests positive for Covid-19 or have been contact traced or are in quarantine, please inform the school immediately.
