ENTRANCE PROTOCOLS

Facemasks are optional for all persons entering the school campus.

Parents are free to send their children with or without a mask.

We kindly request parents to keep child/ren who are not well and having symptoms such as vomiting, diarrhoea, flu-like and running nose, at home.

Kindly note vehicles will **NOT BE** allowed entry through the main gates before **6.50 am**. We request parents to drop off and collect children from their designated drop-off points.

Arrival times:

Reception, Standards 1 to 7 should arrive between 6.50 am to 7.20 am.

Lessons for all standards start at 7.30 am.

Collection times:

Reception & Standard 1	12.30pm to 12.45pm
Standard 2	12.45pm to 1.00pm (Children who stay for remedial lessons on Tuesday will leave at 2.15pm)
Standard 3 & 4	Monday - 3.15pm to 3.30 pm Tuesday - 2.15pm to 2.30pm Wednesday to Friday - 1.00pm to 1.15pm
Standard 5 to 7	Monday - 3.15pm to 3.30 pm Tuesday - 2.15pm to 2.30pm Thursday and Friday - 1.15pm to 1.30pm

Kindly note, parents having more than one child in school may collect all children at the same time. Please inform the class teachers accordingly.

Special Note:

In view of the high temperatures being experienced nationwide, we request parents to pack sufficient drinking water for their children.

School fee payment can be done directly at the school or via bank transfer. Please find the banking details below.

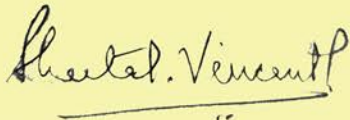

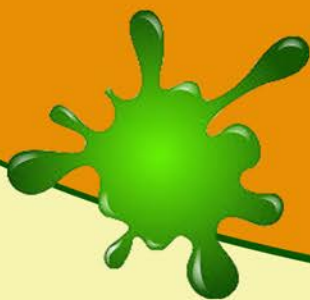

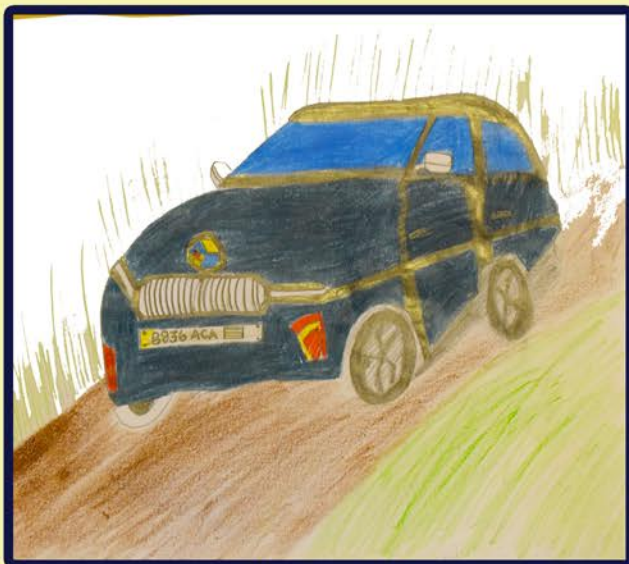
